Easy Smart Doll Apron



This apron was designed for Smart Doll, but should fit similarly-sized BJDs such as Dollfie Dream, Dollfie Dynamite, and Super Dollfie. All measurements are in inches.

To make this apron, you will need:

- Woven (non-stretch) fabric
- ½" ribbon or ½" bias tape for the straps
- Pattern pieces (page 3)

Optional decorations:

- Rickrack
- Ribbon
- Lace

This pattern uses ¼" seam allowance. You may want to use Fray Check, because some raw edges are exposed on the back side.

- 1. If you want to add an iron-on or applique to the torso piece, do it FIRST. Make sure it doesn't stray into the seam allowance.
- 2. Fold over the top $\frac{1}{4}$ " of the torso piece (the short part) to the back and sew it in place.
- 3. Cut 2 pieces of ½" ribbon or bias tape 12" long and sew them along the sides of the torso piece so that their bottom edges line up with the bottom of the torso piece. This will make your shoulder straps.
- 4. Hem the bottom and sides of the skirt piece by folding them over \(\frac{1}{2} \) and topstitching.
- 5. Sew whatever decorations you want to the skirt piece. Lace around the bottom and sides always looks cute. Red rickrack on a white apron looks especially nice for a Christmas design.
- 6. OPTIONAL: Gather the top edge of the skirt piece so that it matches the length of the torso piece.
- 7. Center the skirt piece and sew it onto the bottom of the torso piece.
- 8. Cut a piece of ½" ribbon or bias tape 18" long, center it over the bottom edge of the torso, and sew it on. This will be your waist strap.

You're done! Now tie your new apron onto the doll. ©

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
